2005 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The deep inky red colour holds promise of well ripened fruit. The aromas are of cherries, violets, blackberries, plums and fine chocolate oak. The palate is a mouth filling melange of sweet mulberry, black currants and cherries with excellent firm acidity. The use of French and Hungarian barriques, reveal delightful nutty chocolate toasty characters with a surprising hint of vanilla. Tannins are quite silky and add weight to this exceptional wine. A great wine, proof once again of Margaret River's ability to produce world class Cabernets.
